Login to your account using your email address and password. This username and password are the same to access your school email.




02 Register for Classes


Click the student link on the toolbar at the top of eLearning




On the Student page, locate the side toolbar. Click Advising and Registration to view the page to Add/Drop courses.



On the Advising and Registration page you will be able to choose your courses. Click the Add/Drop link to begin your course selection.




After Clicking the Add/Drop Courses link. You can know search and choose courses for your schedule. Choose the Term.



After clicking search you will be able to choose your courses. After you have clicked the boxes in the add column select add courses.




After selecting add course your schedule will appear. Congratulations you are done registering. Your Advisor will follow-up and grant approval.






